# HAPPY WORLD BOOK DAY

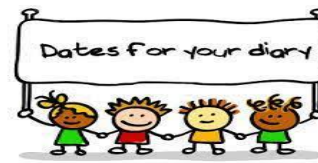
Please find attached to our newsletter details of our World Book Day competitions organised by our Active Ambassadors!
