## Key Stage 2 SATS Week

As SATs Week approaches, we understand how important it is for our students to feel calm, supported, and prepared for the week ahead. To help ease the morning stress, we are offering a special Breakfast for Year 6 pupils from Monday to Thursday of SATs Week. The aim of this breakfast is to help fuel your child's brain and body for their exams, while creating a relaxed atmosphere to start the day.

## Year 4 Multiplication Check

Children in Year 4 will be participating in the multiplication tables check (MTC) in June.

The purpose of the check is to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help your child's school to identify if your child may need additional support. More information on the [check can be found here](#).

### Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

The Phonics screening checks for 2025 will take place in June. The purpose of the phonics screening check is to confirm that all children have learned phonic decoding to an age-appropriate standard. With some exceptions, all pupils who have reached the age of 6 by the end of the school year must take the check. Mr Roberts carries out the checks and children have been prepared for the format of the test so no child should be unnecessarily worried. More information on the [check can be found here](#).
