Breaktime Snacks

Parents in EYFS and KS1 may be aware that free fruit and vegetables are provided daily by school through the Government School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme and so there is no need to send your child with an additional snack.

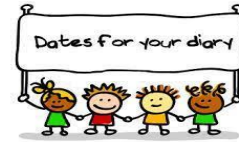


On the afternoon of Thursday 4th September, Narnia launched their Autumn geography topic: "Where is Caythorpe in the UK?" with an exciting Big Bang activity! To kick off their learning, they went on a walk around the village, exploring and photographing key features of Caythorpe. The children were brilliant at spotting landmarks and thinking about what makes our village unique. This hands-on experience will help them build a deeper understanding of the local area and how it fits into the wider UK.

Back in class the children explored Caythorpe using a range of maps including Ordnance Survey maps, Google Maps, Google Earth and atlases. They did a fantastic job identifying both human and physical features of our village and comparing how each map presents information.



Hogwarts kicked off their South American Learning with a food tasting of some South American delights. They had - Pao de Queijo - a rustic cheesy bread, Brigadeiro - a sweet sticky chocolate treat, Salsa - a flavourful sauce, which Hogwarts will be making more of during their DT lessons.
