Hogwarts's Visit to the Newark Civil War Museum

During Hogwarts's visit to the Newark Civil War Museum, they took part in a fascinating tour walk that brought the history of the English Civil War to life through stories and local landmarks. The museum staff also ran engaging sessions on arms and armour, where we had the chance to explore replicas and original artefacts, learning how they were used and what they reveal about life during the conflict.



The children engaged with a lot of artefacts with Summer stating the beautifully decorated sword was her favourite and Joshua liking the cannon ball they pulled out of the Newark church spire. Mr Grimwood believes it was one of the best experiences he's been on.

To kick off Narnia's History enquiry, "What did the Romans ever do for us?", the children explored a range of Roman artefacts, including vases, toys, notebooks, and coins, sparking lots of curiosity and discussion.

This hands-on session led beautifully into our first History lesson, where we learned about how the Romans invaded Britain. The children worked in groups to sequence key events of the Roman invasion in chronological order. A fantastic start to our Roman journey!

Stranger Danger


